Frequently Asked Questions

Q: How long does each program take?

A: Each program runs for 90 minutes directly following school, 1 day a week for 4 weeks.

Q: My child is interested in a program but it isn't listed under my child's school, will he be able to participate? A: Every 4 weeks a new rotation of programs will be available at your school, chances are if it isn't available 1 month it will be in the future.

Q: Will there be a time for snack?

A: Yes, each program will have a specific amount of time set aside for snacks, however ASE does not provide a snack. Children must bring their own snack from home.

Q: Can I register my child for more than 1 program?

A: Yes, as long as that program is offered at your child(s) school then registration is open to all children until the maximum number is reached.

Q: My child attends the CLC can they participate in the ASE program?

A: Yes, the program instructor will escort all children that attend the CLC program upon the completion of each class.

Q: Does my child need to bring any supplies?

A: ASE will provide all the materials needed for the program.
